Summary of Legislation

This bill prohibits a contract for the transportation of property from requiring that the customer release the motor carrier from all liability resulting from the motor carrier's own negligent or intentional acts.

Local Government Impact

Local governments may experience a minimal increase in costs for transportation services when a motor carrier pays additional insurance costs due to limits on indemnification and thereby passes the costs onto a local government. However, at this time, the possible increase cannot be quantified.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 6, 2014, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 7, 2014, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
