101	CONCERNING ADOPTION OF A SCHOOL CLOSURE PLAN AS A
102	REQUIREMENT FOR CLOSING A LOW-PERFORMING PUBLIC
103	SCHOOL.

Bill Summary

The bill requires a school district or the state charter school institute, if it decides or is directed by the state board of education to close a public school because of low performance, to adopt a school closure plan that addresses communications, the timeline for the closure,

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-11-307, add (5)
3	as follows:
4	22-11-307. Accreditation of public schools. (5) IF A LOCAL
5	SCHOOL BOARD OR THE INSTITUTE DECIDES OR IS DIRECTED BY THE STATE
6	BOARD TO CLOSE A PUBLIC SCHOOL BECAUSE OF LOW PERFORMANCE, THE
7	SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE INSTITUTE MUST DEVELOP AND UPDATE AS
8	NECESSARY A SCHOOL CLOSURE PLAN THAT IMPLEMENTS EVIDENCE-BASED
9	BEST PRACTICES DURING THE SCHOOL CLOSURE PROCESS TO ENSURE THAT
10	STUDENTS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT IS CLOSED
11	ARE FULLY SUPPORTED IN ENROLLING IN THE SUCCESSOR PUBLIC SCHOOL,
12	IF ANY, OR IN ANOTHER PUBLIC SCHOOL. THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OR
13	THE INSTITUTE SHALL MAKE THE SCHOOL CLOSURE PLAN AND ANY
14	UPDATES AVAILABLE TO THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL, THE LOCAL
15	TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, IF ANY, THE PARENTS OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN
16	THE PUBLIC SCHOOL, AND THE COMMUNITY SURROUNDING THE PUBLIC
17	SCHOOL. AT A MINIMUM, THE SCHOOL CLOSURE PLAN MUST INCLUDE:
18	(a) A PLAN FOR COMMUNICATING WITH PARENTS, SCHOOL STAFF,
19	THE LOCAL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, IF ANY, AND THE COMMUNITY
20	SURROUNDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE AFTER THE
21	LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OR THE INSTITUTE DECIDES TO CLOSE THE
22	PUBLIC SCHOOL AND AT REGULAR INTERVALS THROUGHOUT THE CLOSURE
23	PROCESS;
24	(b) A TIMELINE FOR CLOSING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT INCLUDES
25	OR IS UPDATED TO INCLUDE ALL MAJOR STEPS AND DECISION POINTS IN

1	COMPLETING THE SCHOOL CLOSURE AND STARTS NO LATER THAN THE
2	DECISION TO CLOSE AND CONTINUES AT LEAST THROUGH THE
3	REASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS AND THE OPENING OF A NEW PUBLIC SCHOOL,
4	IF APPLICABLE; AND
5	(c) A PLAN FOR REASSIGNING STUDENTS TO OTHER PUBLIC
6	SCHOOLS, WHICH MUST, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE, TAKE INTO
7	ACCOUNT PARENTS' CHOICE CONCERNING THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO WHICH
8	STUDENTS ARE REASSIGNED.
9	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
