The bill continues the existing foreclosure deferment program, which is scheduled to expire in 2014, until 2015.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 38-38-808 as
3	follows:
4	38-38-808. Repeal of part. This part 8 is repealed, effective June
5	30, 2014 September 1, 2015.
6	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds
7	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
8	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
