A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE DURATION OF A LICENSE TO USE A REGISTRATION NUMBER WHEN AUCTIONED TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE DISABILITY-BENEFIT SUPPORT FUND.

Bill Summary

The bill changes the duration of a license to use a registration number purchased at auction from perpetual to a limited time determined by the license plate auction group.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-1-402, amend (2)
3	as follows:
4	42-1-402. License to buy and sell selected registration numbers
5	for license plates. (2) The right to use a registration number is a
6	perpetual license, the use of which is subject to compliance with this part
7	4. THE DURATION OF THE LICENSE IS DETERMINED BY THE GROUP.
8	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
9	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
