2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-1-402, **amend** (2)
3 as follows:

4 **42-1-402. License to buy and sell selected registration numbers**
5 **for license plates.** (2) The right to use a registration number is a
6 ~~perpetual~~ license, the use of which is subject to compliance with this part
7 4. THE DURATION OF THE LICENSE IS DETERMINED BY THE GROUP.

8 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
