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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING THE DIVERSION OF REVENUE COLLECTED BY THE**  
102 **DIVISION OF INSURANCE TO CASH FUNDS.**

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**Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** All taxes, penalties, and fines collected by the division of insurance are currently deposited in the general fund; except that the general assembly can direct this revenue to be deposited in the division of insurance cash fund, the wildfire emergency response fund, and the wildfire preparedness fund. 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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-3-209, **amend** (4)

3 (a) as follows:

4 **10-3-209. Tax on premiums collected - exemptions - penalties**

5 **- repeal.** (4) (a) THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE SHALL TRANSMIT all taxes,

6           **SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act takes effect  
7 July 1, 2014, and applies to state fiscal years commencing on or after said  
8 date.

9           **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
