#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A PROVISIONAL PHYSICAL THERAPIST LICENSE.

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill allows the physical therapy board to issue a provisional license to applicants who have successfully completed a physical therapy program, met the educational requirements, and paid a fee. A person with a provisional license is required to practice under the supervision of a licensed physical therapist. The provisional license expires no later than 90 days after issuance.

2	<b>SECTION 1.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>add</b> 12-41-107.5 as
3	follows:
4	<b>12-41-107.5. Provisional license - fee.</b> (1) The BOARD MAY ISSUE
5	A PROVISIONAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST TO A
6	PERSON WHO:
7	(a) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION AND PAYS A FEE AS DETERMINED BY
8	THE DIRECTOR; AND
9	(b) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES A PHYSICAL THERAPY PROGRAM
10	THAT MEETS THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS IN SECTION $12-41-107(1)$
11	(a).
12	(2) A PERSON WHO HOLDS A PROVISIONAL LICENSE MAY ONLY
13	PRACTICE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A PHYSICAL THERAPIST $\underline{ACTIVELY}$
14	LICENSED <u>IN THIS STATE.</u>
15	(3) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
16	EXPIRES NO LATER THAN <u>ONE HUNDRED TWENTY</u> DAYS AFTER THE DATE
17	IT WAS ISSUED. <u>A PROVISIONAL LICENSE MAY ONLY BE ISSUED ONE TIME</u>
18	AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO SECTION 12-41-112.
19	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-41-115, amend
20	(1) (e) as follows:
21	<b>12-41-115. Grounds for disciplinary action.</b> (1) The board may
22	take disciplinary action in accordance with section 12-41-116 against a
23	person who has:
24	(e) Failed to provide adequate or proper supervision when
25	utilizing unlicensed persons OR PERSONS WITH A PROVISIONAL LICENSE in
26	a physical therapy practice;

<b>SECTION </b> <u>3.</u> <b>Act subject to petition - effective date.</b> This act
takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a
referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
