## **Bill Summary**

Under current law, a prescription drug outlet may only distribute compounded drugs for office use to practitioners who are authorized to prescribe drugs. The bill allows a prescription drug outlet to also distribute compounded drugs to a hospital located in Colorado.

6	pharmacist Prescription drug outlet located in this state to
7	compound drugs for office use by a practitioner OR FOR USE BY A
8	HOSPITAL LOCATED IN THIS STATE. The rules must limit the amount of
9	drugs a pharmacist PRESCRIPTION DRUG OUTLET may compound AND
10	DISTRIBUTE TO A PRACTITIONER OR HOSPITAL PURSUANT TO THIS
11	PARAGRAPH (b) to no more than ten percent of the total number of drug
12	dosage units dispensed and distributed on an annual basis by the outlet.
13	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
14	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
15	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
