1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, add (1) (b)
3	(II) (I) as follows:
4	42-3-213. Special plates - military veterans - rules - retirement.
5	(1) (b) (II) Notwithstanding subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (b):
6	(I) The department shall not charge a fee for one set of
7	DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES ISSUED UNDER
8	SUBSECTION (25) OF THIS SECTION IF THE CROSS WAS AWARDED FOR
9	VALOR.
10	SECTION 2. Appropriation. (1) In addition to any other
11	appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
12	Colorado state titling and registration account of the highway users tax
13	fund created in section 42-1-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not
14	otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year
15	beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$824, or so much thereof as may be
16	necessary, for the purchase of computer programming services related
17	to the implementation of this act.
18	(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
19	appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
20	budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$824, or
21	so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of
22	information technology, for the provision of computer center services for
23	the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said
24	sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of
25	revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 1 2 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 3 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 4 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 5 6 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 7 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 8 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 9 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor. 10
