Sunset Process - House Health, Insurance and Environment Committee. The bill continues the nurse-physician advisory task force for Colorado health care through September 1, 2020.

Prior to such THE repeal, the 7 DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES SHALL REVIEW THE functions of 8 the NPATCH shall be reviewed as provided in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (3) 10 (aa) (V); and add (3) (gg.5) as follows: 11 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. The general assembly hereby finds, 21 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 22 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
