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1             WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 37-95-107.8, Colorado Revised  
2 Statutes, the Drinking Water Revolving Fund (DWRF) has been created  
3 in the Colorado Water Resources and Power Development Authority  
4 (Authority) to provide financial assistance for certain drinking water  
5 supply projects; and

6             WHEREAS, Pursuant to sections 37-95-103 (4.8) and 37-95-107.8  
7 (4) (c), Colorado Revised Statutes, in order to qualify for financial  
8 assistance from the DWRF, proposed projects must be included on the

2 WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 37-95-107.8 (4) (b), Colorado  
3 Revised Statutes, the Water Quality Control Commission (Commission)  
4 has developed additions, modifications, or deletions to the Drinking  
5 Water Project Eligibility List; and

6 WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 37-95-107.6, Colorado Revised  
7 Statutes, the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (WPCRF) has been  
8 created in the Authority to provide financial assistance for certain  
9 wastewater treatment system projects; and

10 WHEREAS, Pursuant to sections 37-95-103 (13.5) and  
11 37-95-107.6 (4) (c), Colorado Revised Statutes, in order to qualify for  
12 assistance from the WPCRF, proposed projects must be included on the  
13 Water Pollution Control Project Eligibility List; and

14 WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 37-95-107.6 (4) (b), Colorado  
15 Revised Statutes, the Commission has developed additions,  
16 modifications, or deletions to the Water Pollution Control Project  
17 Eligibility List; and

18 WHEREAS, The provision of financial assistance from the DWRF  
19 and the WPCRF to the proposed projects will preserve, protect, conserve,  
20 and develop the water resources of the state; promote the beneficial use  
21 of the waters of the state and the protection and preservation of the public  
22 health, safety, and welfare; create and preserve jobs and employment  
23 opportunities; and improve the economic welfare of the people of the  
24 state; and

25 WHEREAS, The General Assembly deems the additions and  
26 modifications to the Drinking Water Project Eligibility List and the Water  
27 Pollution Control Project Eligibility List adopted by the Commission to  
28 be in the interest and to the advantage of the people of the state; now,  
29 therefore,

30 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Sixty-ninth General Assembly*  
31 *of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*
