A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING TRANSFERS OF MONEYS RELATED TO CAPITAL
102 CONSTRUCTION.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. For the 2014-15 fiscal year, the bill transfers \$219,993,465 from the general fund to the capital construction fund and \$500,000 from the general fund exempt account of the general fund to the capital construction fund.

For the 2014-15 fiscal year, the bill transfers \$1 million from the

state historical fund to the capital construction fund for historical renovations of the state house of representatives' chambers and the state senate's chambers.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302, **amend**
3 (2) introductory portion, (2) (z), (2.5) introductory portion, (2.5) (g), and
4 (2.5) (h); and **add** (2) (aa) and (2.5) (i) as follows:

5 **24-75-302. Capital construction fund - capital assessment fees**
6 **- calculation.** (2) On July 1 of each year through ~~July 1, 2013~~ JULY 1,
7 2014, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as
8 specified in this subsection (2) out of the general fund and into the capital
9 construction fund as moneys become available in the general fund during
10 the fiscal year beginning on said July 1. Transfers between funds pursuant
11 to this subsection (2) are not appropriations subject to the limitations of
12 section 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to this subsection
13 (2) are as follows:

14 (z) On July 1, 2013, one hundred eighty-six million two hundred
15 fifteen thousand four hundred ninety-three dollars; AND

16 (aa) ON JULY 1, 2014, TWO HUNDRED NINETEEN MILLION NINE
17 HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS.

18 (2.5) In addition to the sums accrued pursuant to subsection (2) of
19 this section, on July 1 of each year through ~~July 1, 2013~~ JULY 1, 2014, the
20 state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as specified in this
21 subsection (2.5) from the general fund exempt account of the general
22 fund created pursuant to section 24-77-103.6 to the capital construction
23 fund as moneys become available in the general fund exempt account
24 during the fiscal year beginning on said July 1. Transfers between funds

1 pursuant to this subsection (2.5) are not appropriations subject to the
2 limitations of section 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to
3 this subsection (2.5) are as follows:

4 (g) On July 1, 2012, five hundred thousand dollars; ~~and~~

5 (h) On July 1, 2013, five hundred thousand dollars; AND

6 (i) ON JULY 1, 2014, FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS.

7 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47.1-1201, **add**
8 (6) as follows:

9 **12-47.1-1201. State historical fund - administration -**
10 **legislative declaration - state museum cash fund - capitol dome**
11 **restoration fund.** (6) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2014,
12 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ONE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE
13 STATE HISTORICAL FUND AT THE BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR TO THE
14 CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-75-302, C.R.S.,
15 FOR HISTORIC RENOVATION OF THE STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES'
16 CHAMBERS AND THE STATE SENATE'S CHAMBERS.

17 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
19 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
