Bill Summary

The bill adds to the definition of "other outlet" under the statutes governing the practice of pharmacy a telepharmacy outlet located more than 20 miles from the nearest pharmacy. A prescribing practitioner cannot own a telepharmacy, and the state board of pharmacy is authorized HOUSE 3rd Reading Unamended March 17, 2014

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-42.5-102, amend
3	(39); and add (25) (c) and (40.5) as follows:
4	12-42.5-102. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the
5	context otherwise requires or the term is otherwise defined in another part
6	of this article:
7	(25) "Other outlet" means:
8	(c) A TELEPHARMACY OUTLET.
9	(39) "Supervision" means that a licensed pharmacist is on the
10	location and readily available to consult with and assist unlicensed
11	personnel performing tasks described in paragraph (b) of subsection (31)
12	of this section. IF THE UNLICENSED PERSON IS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN
13	LOCATED AT A REGISTERED TELEPHARMACY OUTLET, THE LICENSED
14	PHARMACIST NEED NOT BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT AT THE TELEPHARMACY
15	OUTLET AS LONG AS THE LICENSED PHARMACIST IS CONNECTED TO THE
16	TELEPHARMACY OUTLET VIA COMPUTER LINK, VIDEOLINK, AND
17	AUDIOLINK, OR VIA OTHER TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT OF

10 (b) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES AS NECESSARY TO SPECIFY
11 ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR A TELEPHARMACY OUTLET THAT THE BOARD
12 DEEMS NECESSARY.

13 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 14 15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 16 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a 17 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 18 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 19 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 20 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 21 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
