Bill Summary

The bill adds to the definition of "other outlet" under the statutes governing the practice of pharmacy a telepharmacy outlet located more than 20 miles from the nearest pharmacy. SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 14 15 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 16 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 17 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a 18 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 19 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 20 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 21 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 22 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
