101 CONCERNING PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS AWARDED THROUGH NURSING  
102 FACILITY PROVIDER REIMBURSEMENT APPEALS FROM THE  
103 MEDICAID NURSING FACILITY CASH FUND.

Bill Summary

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill authorizes appropriations from the medicaid nursing facility cash fund to satisfy settlements or judgments resulting from nursing facility provider reimbursement appeals.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-6-203, **amend**

3 (2) (b) (I) as follows:

4 **25.5-6-203. Nursing facilities - provider fees - federal waiver**

5 **- fund created - rules.** (2) (b) (I) All moneys in the fund shall be subject

6 to federal matching as authorized under federal law and subject to annual

7 appropriation by the general assembly for the purpose of paying the

8 administrative costs of implementing section 25.5-6-202 and this section,

9 TO SATISFY SETTLEMENTS OR JUDGMENTS RESULTING FROM NURSING

10 FACILITY PROVIDER REIMBURSEMENT APPEALS, and to pay the

11 supplemental medicaid payments to offset payment of the provider fee

12 established under section 25.5-6-202 (7).

13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
