### A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 101 CONCERNING THE ABILITY OF A COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER TO
- 102 SEEK JUDICIAL REVIEW OF FINAL ACTION BY THE SECRETARY OF
- 103 STATE RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

#### **Bill Summary**

The bill allows a county clerk and recorder to seek judicial review of final agency action by the secretary of state with regard to elections.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-1-110, add (1.5)
3 as follows:

1-1-110. Powers of the county clerk and recorder and deputy
- communication to electors. (1.5) PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-4-106
(4.7), C.R.S., A COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER IS AUTHORIZED TO SEEK
JUDICIAL REVIEW OF FINAL ACTION UNDERTAKEN BY THE SECRETARY OF
STATE ARISING UNDER THIS CODE.

9 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-4-106, add (4.7)
10 as follows:

11 **24-4-106.** Judicial review. (4.7) The County Clerk and 12 RECORDER OF ANY COUNTY MAY COMMENCE AN ACTION UNDER THIS 13 SECTION IN THE DENVER DISTRICT COURT FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF ANY 14 FINAL ACTION ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE ARISING UNDER THE 15 "UNIFORM ELECTION CODE OF 1992", ARTICLES 1 TO 13 OF TITLE 1, C.R.S. 16 IN ANY SUCH ACTION, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER MAY SEEK 17 TEMPORARY OR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIVE RELIEF PENDING A FINAL 18 DECISION ON THE MERITS OF THE CLAIM AS PERMITTED UNDER THIS 19 SECTION.

20 **SECTION 3.** Applicability. This act applies to final actions 21 issued by the secretary of state on or after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
