#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATIVE 102 DEPARTMENT.

### **Bill Summary**

The bill makes appropriations for matters related to the legislative department for the 2014-15 state fiscal year. The bill makes an appropriation to the youth advisory council cash fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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| 2  | SECTION 1. Appropriation. In addition to any other   |
| 3  | appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, to the legislative department   |
| 4  | of the state of Colorado, the sum of \$38,173,003, or so much thereof as   |
| 5  | may be necessary, of which amount \$37,090,187 shall be out of any   |
| 6  | moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, \$179,000 shall be  |
| 7  | from cash funds, and \$903,816 shall be from reappropriated funds, for   |
| 8  | payment of the expenses of the legislative department for the fiscal year  |
| 9  | beginning July 1, 2014, to be allocated as follows:  |

| 10 | the tax levy on civil actions provided for in section 2-5-119,            |
| 11 | Colorado Revised Statutes, will return approximately \$310,000 to         |
| 12 | the general fund to offset expenses of the revision of statutes by        |
| 13 | the office of legislative legal services.                                 |
| 14 | SECTION 2. Appropriation. In addition to any other                        |
| 15 | appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the     |
| 16 | general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the youth advisory council    |
| 17 | cash fund created in section 2-2-1306, Colorado Revised Statutes, for the |
| 18 | fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$8,472, to be used for    |
| 19 | purposes consistent with the creation of the fund.                        |
| 20 | SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,              |
| 21 | determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate     |
| 22 | preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.                     |

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
