A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PARKS AND WILDLIFE
102	COMMISSION TO PURCHASE REAL PROPERTY TO BUILD A
103	MULTI-USE SHOOTING FACILITY.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill authorizes the parks and wildlife commission to purchase property to build a multi-use shooting facility using appropriated funds, non-appropriated grant funds, or federal moneys.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-1-105, add (1) (i)

6	(i) (I) PURCHASE, WITHOUT USING THE BID PROCESS REQUIRED BY
7	SECTION 33-1-105.5, NO MORE THAN TWO THOUSAND ACRES OF REAL
8	PROPERTY IN MESA COUNTY TO BUILD A MULTI-USE SHOOTING FACILITY
9	USING MONEYS RECEIVED FROM:
10	(A) APPROPRIATED FUNDS OR NONAPPROPRIATED GRANT MONEYS;
11	OR
12	(B) THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
13	(II) THE COMMISSION MAY CONTRACT WITH AN INDEPENDENT
14	CONTRACTOR TO BUILD OR OPERATE THE MULTI-USE SHOOTING FACILITY
15	AUTHORIZED BY THIS PARAGRAPH (i).
16	(III) This paragraph (i) is repealed, effective July 1, 2020.

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takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
