

## RETURN ON INVESTMENT CALCULATION

The Unemployment Insurance Division has seen a higher average earnings and entered employment rate for those claimants who received the program benefits. For example, the average entered employment rate for claimants in the program (from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2013) was 71.67 percent, while the entered employment rate for all claimants registered with the workforce system, but not in the program, was 56.83 percent and 53.17 percent for Wagner Peyser customers. Below is a table of additional performance data.
