Felonies classified - presumptive penalties. 14 (1) (b) (IV) If a person is convicted of assault in the first degree pursuant 15 to section 18-3-202 or assault in the second degree pursuant to section 16 18-3-203 and the victim is a peace officer, firefighter, or emergency 17 medical service provider engaged in the performance of his or her duties, 18 as defined in section 18-1.3-501 (1.5) (b), notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (III) of paragraph (a) of this subsection (1) and 19 20 subparagraph (II) of this paragraph (b), the court shall sentence the person 21 to the department of corrections. In addition to a term of imprisonment, 22 the court may impose a fine on the person pursuant to subparagraph (III) of paragraph (a) of this subsection (1).". 23
