HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT
Committee on Business Affairs and Labor.HB15-1206 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, lines 5 and 6, strike "recycling or
2 reprocessing of waste products" and substitute "waste reduction or
3 recycling equipment".
- 4 Page 3, line 8, strike "ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING OR" and
5 substitute "THAT OPERATES A RECYCLING FACILITY OR A COMPOSTING
6 FACILITY REGISTERED WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
7 ENVIRONMENT".
- 8 Page 3, line 9, strike "REPROCESSING WASTE PRODUCTS".
- 9 Page 3, strike lines 12 through 14 and substitute "OR SALE OF ANY WASTE
10 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT."
- 11 Page 3, line 25, strike "MACHINERY OR" and substitute "WASTE
12 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING".
- 13 Page 4, strike lines 8 through 27 and substitute:
14 (a) "HOME SCRAP" MEANS MATERIALS OR BY-PRODUCTS
15 GENERATED FROM AND COMMONLY REUSED WITHIN AN ORIGINAL
16 MANUFACTURING PROCESS;
17 (b) "MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTION
18 42-1-102 (58), C.R.S.;
19 (c) "POSTCONSUMER WASTE" MEANS PRODUCTS OR OTHER
20 MATERIALS GENERATED BY A BUSINESS, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR
21 CONSUMER THAT HAVE SERVED THEIR INTENDED END USE AND HAVE BEEN
22 RECOVERED FROM OR OTHERWISE DIVERTED FROM THE SOLID WASTE
23 STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING;
24 (d) "PRECONSUMER MATERIAL" MEANS MATERIAL GENERATED
25 DURING ANY STEP IN THE PRODUCTION OF A PRODUCT AND RECOVERED OR
26 OTHERWISE DIVERTED FROM THE SOLID WASTE STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE
27 OF RECYCLING BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE HOME SCRAP;
28 (e) "RECOVERED MATERIALS" MEANS THOSE MATERIALS THAT
29 HAVE BEEN SEPARATED, DIVERTED, OR REMOVED FROM THE WASTE
30 STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING AND INCLUDES PRECONSUMER
31 MATERIAL AND POSTCONSUMER WASTE BUT NOT HOME SCRAP;
32 (f) "RECYCLING" MEANS THE SYSTEMATIC COLLECTING, SORTING,
33 DECONTAMINATING, AND RETURNING OF WASTE MATERIALS TO COMMERCE



1 AS COMMODITIES FOR USE OR EXCHANGE;

2 (g) "SOLID WASTE" MEANS ALL PUTRESCIBLE AND
3 NONPUTRESCIBLE WASTES IN SOLID OR SEMISOLID FORM, INCLUDING, BUT
4 NOT LIMITED TO, YARD OR FOOD WASTE, WASTE GLASS, WASTE METALS,
5 WASTE PLASTICS, WASTEPAPERS, WASTE PAPERBOARD, AND ALL OTHER
6 SOLID OR SEMISOLID WASTES RESULTING FROM INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL,
7 AGRICULTURAL, COMMUNITY, AND RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES; AND

8 (h) (I) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" MEANS
9 NEW OR USED MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT WHICH IS OPERATED OR USED
10 EXCLUSIVELY IN THE STATE TO COLLECT, SEPARATE, PROCESS, MODIFY,
11 CONVERT, OR TREAT SOLID WASTE SO THAT THE RESULTING PRODUCT MAY
12 BE USED AS A RAW MATERIAL OR FOR PRODUCTIVE USE OR TO
13 MANUFACTURE PRODUCTS CONTAINING RECOVERED MATERIALS. "WASTE
14 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" INCLUDES DEVICES WHICH ARE
15 DIRECTLY CONNECTED WITH OR ARE AN INTEGRAL AND NECESSARY PART
16 OF SUCH MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT AND ARE NECESSARY FOR SUCH
17 COLLECTION, SEPARATION, PROCESSING, MODIFICATION, CONVERSION,
18 TREATMENT, OR MANUFACTURING.

19 (II) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" DOES NOT
20 INCLUDE MOTOR VEHICLES."

21 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 12.
