 - (c) ADVISE THE TONY GRAMPSAS YOUTH SERVICES BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT REGARDING SUCH BEST PRACTICES; AND
 - (d) PROVIDE ADVICE REGARDING DUPLICATIVE SERVICES AND GAPS IN SERVICES BEING PROVIDED STATEWIDE THROUGH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES, NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, AND PRIVATE PROVIDERS.
- 22 (2) THE COUNCIL HAS THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL SPECIFIC 23 DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS:
- 24 (a) TO ESTABLISH REGIONAL COUNCILS ACROSS THE STATE TO COORDINATE THE PROVISION OF SERVICES TO YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS AND TO RECOMMEND BEST PRACTICES FOR SUCH SERVICES TO THE

- 27 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
- state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
- 29 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect



- 1 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
- 2 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 3 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.".
