

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 15-1023**

First Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill changes the lower and upper age limit for persons served by a day treatment center from at least 5 years of age to at least 3 years of age and from less than 18 years of age to less than 21 years of age, unless the person who is 21 years of age is completing an educational program.

Italicized words indicate new material added to the original summary; dashes through words indicate deletions from the original summary.
