Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1170 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 14, before line 11 insert:

2 "SECTION 7. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2015-16 state fiscal
3 year, \$92,934 is appropriated to the department of education. This
4 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on the assumption that
5 the department will require an additional 0.7 FTE. To implement this act,
6 the department may use this appropriation for longitudinal analyses of
7 student assessment results.

8 (2) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$118,969 is appropriated to
9 the department of labor and employment. This appropriation is from the
10 general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this
11 appropriation as follows:

12 (a) \$98,969 for use by the workforce development council, which
13 amount is based on an assumption that the council will require an
14 additional 1.0 FTE; and

15 (b) \$20,000 for the purchase of information technology services.

16 (3) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$20,000 is appropriated to
17 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
18 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
19 department of labor and employment under paragraph (b) of subsection
20 (2) of this section. To implement this act, the office may use this
21 appropriation to provide information technology services for the
22 department of labor and employment."
