**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$30,851 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2015-16. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.5 FTE to implement the act.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2015-16 based on the March 2015 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package allocates a total of \$18.5

million General Fund to be available to fund 2015 legislation. If the full \$18.5 million is not used to fund legislation, it will remain in the General Fund reserve.
