Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB15-014 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Health and Human Services Committee Report, dated  
2 February 26, 2015, page 8, strike lines 23 through 41.

3 Page 9 of the report, strike lines 1 through 4.

4 Page 9 of the report, line 5, strike "6." and substitute "5."

5 Page 9 of the report, after line 16 insert:

6           **"SECTION 6. Appropriation.** For the 2015-16 state fiscal year,  
7 \$60,000 is appropriated to the department of public safety for use by the  
8 Colorado crime information center. This appropriation is from the  
9 marijuana tax cash fund created in section 39-28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. To  
10 implement this act, the department of public safety may use this  
11 appropriation for the collection of medical marijuana information.

12           **SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2015-16 state fiscal  
13 year, \$1,068,560 is appropriated to the department of public health and  
14 environment. This appropriation is from the medical marijuana program  
15 cash fund created in section 25-1.5-106 (16) (a), C.R.S. To implement  
16 this act, the department of public health and environment may use this  
17 appropriation for the purchase of information technology services.

18           (2) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$1,068,560 is appropriated  
19 to the office of the governor for use by the office of information  
20 technology. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received

1 from the department of public health and environment under subsection  
2 (1) of this section. To implement this act, the office may use this  
3 appropriation to provide information technology services for the  
4 department of public health and environment.

5 **SECTION 8. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2015-16 state fiscal  
6 year, \$113,704 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This  
7 appropriation is from the marijuana tax cash fund created in section 39-  
8 28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this  
9 appropriation as follows:

10 (a) \$56,998 for use by marijuana enforcement division for  
11 personal services and operating expenses, which amount is based on an  
12 assumption that the department will require an additional 1.0 FTE; and

13 (b) \$56,706 for the purchase of legal services.

14 (2) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$56,706 is appropriated to  
15 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
16 received from the department of revenue under paragraph (b) of  
17 subsection (1) of this section, and is based on an assumption that the  
18 department will require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the  
19 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for  
20 the department of revenue."

21 Page 9 of the report, line 17, strike "7." and substitute "9."

22 Page 9 of the report, line 20, strike "8." and substitute "10."

23 Page 9 of the report, after line 22 insert:

24 "Amend the printed bill, page 1, line 102, strike "REVENUE." and  
25 substitute "REVENUE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING  
26 APPROPRIATIONS."."
