Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$107,241 General Fund and \$848 reappropriated funds for FY 2015-16, including \$102,970 General Fund appropriated to the Legislative Department, \$4,271 General Fund appropriated to the Department of Local Affairs, and \$848 reappropriated funds appropriated to the Governor's Office.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2015-16 based on the March 2015 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package allocates a total of \$18.5 million General Fund to be available to fund 2015 legislation. If the full \$18.5 million is not used to fund legislation, it will remain in the General Fund reserve.

Technical Issues

If this bill is prioritized by Legislative Council as an interim committee bill, the total appropriation required for this bill will be reduced by \$2,970 General Fund.
