After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1026 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "(3) (b) (II),".

2 Page 2, strike lines 14 through 17.

3 Page 3, after line 9, insert:

4 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, **amend**
5 (3) (b) (II) as follows:

6 **42-3-204. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -**
7 **applicability - definitions - rules. (3) Types of plates or placards.**
8 **(b) Number of placards and license plates allowed. (II)** The
9 department may issue a ~~disabled-veteran~~ MILITARY license plate UNDER
10 SECTION 42-3-213 OR 42-3-218 (3) with an additional identifying figure
11 and one placard to an individual.

12 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, **amend** (3)
13 (b) (II) as enacted by House Bill 15-1136 as follows:

14 **42-3-204. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -**
15 **applicability - definitions - rules. (3) Types of plates or placards.**
16 **(b) Number of placards and license plates allowed. (II)** The
17 department may issue two ~~disabled-veteran~~ MILITARY license plates
18 UNDER SECTION 42-3-213 OR 42-3-218 (3) with identifying figures or a
19 ~~disabled-veteran~~ ONE MILITARY license plate UNDER SECTION 42-3-213 OR
20 42-3-218 (3) with an additional identifying figure and one placard to an
21 a qualified individual."

1 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

2 Page 5, strike lines 7 through 18 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 7. Act subject to petition - effective date.**

4 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, this act takes effect at
5 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period
6 after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 5, 2015, if
7 adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a referendum
8 petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state
9 constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within
10 such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless
11 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November
12 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official
13 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

14 (2) Section 2 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 15-1136
15 does not become law, in which case section 2 takes effect on the effective
16 date of this act.

17 (3) Section 3 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 15-1136
18 becomes law, in which case section 3 takes effect on the effective date of
19 this act or House Bill 15-1136, whichever is later."
