	HB15-1282 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
1 2	Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:
3	"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 25-2-112.7 as
4	follows:
5	25-2-112.7. Crime of misrepresentation of material
6	information in the preparation of a birth certificate - definitions.
7	(1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE
8	REQUIRES:
9	(a) "BIRTH PARENT" MEANS A NATURAL PARENT, BY BIRTH, OF A
10	CHILD BORN IN THIS STATE. "BIRTH PARENT" ALSO INCLUDES A PRESUMED
11	FATHER OR PUTATIVE FATHER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRESUMPTIONS
12	FOR DETERMINATION OF PATERNITY AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 25-2-112
13	(3), OR A PUTATIVE FATHER THAT IS NOT MARRIED TO THE MOTHER WHO
14	SIGNS A VOLUNTARY ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PATERNITY.
15	(b) "MATERIAL INFORMATION" MEANS THE LEGAL NAME OF A
16	BIRTH PARENT, THE BIRTH DATE OF A BIRTH PARENT, THE MOTHER'S
17	MAIDEN NAME PRIOR TO A FIRST MARRIAGE, IF APPLICABLE, AND THE
18	PLACE OF BIRTH OF A BIRTH PARENT.
19	(2) A BIRTH PARENT COMMITS THE CRIME OF MISREPRESENTATION
20	OF MATERIAL INFORMATION IN THE PREPARATION OF A BIRTH CERTIFICATE
21	IF THE BIRTH PARENT KNOWINGLY AND INTENTIONALLY MISREPRESENTS
22	MATERIAL INFORMATION THAT IS USED TO CREATE A CHILD'S BIRTH
23	CERTIFICATE.

(3) The crime of misrepresentation of material information in the preparation of a birth certificate is a class 2 misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-2-118, **amend** (1) as follows:

25-2-118. Penalties. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 25-2-112.7 WITH RESPECT TO MISREPRESENTATION OF MATERIAL INFORMATION IN THE PREPARATION OF A BIRTH CERTIFICATE, any person who knowingly and willfully makes any false statement in or supplies any false information for or for purposes of deception applies for, alters, mutilates, uses, attempts to use, applies for amendments thereto, or furnishes to another for deceptive use any vital statistics certificate, and any person who knowingly and willfully and for purposes of deception uses or attempts to use or furnishes for use by another any vital statistics certificate knowing that such certificate contains false information or relates to a person other than the person with respect to whom it purports to relate, and any person who manufactures, advertises for sale, sells, or alters any vital statistics certificate knowing or having reason to know that such document establishes or may be used to establish a false status, occupation, membership, license, privilege, or identity for himself or any other person, and any person who uses any such document to commit a crime is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-2-112, **add** (7) as follows:

25-2-112. Certificates of birth - filing - establishment of paternity. (7) The State Registrar shall revise the birth certificate worksheet form used for the preparation of a certificate of live birth to include a statement that knowingly and intentionally misrepresenting material information on the worksheet form used for the preparation of a birth certificate is a class 2 misdemeanor.

SECTION 4. Effective date - applicability. This act takes effect July 1, 2015, and applies to offenses committed on or after said date.

SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
