A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING A STUDY REGARDING THE CREATION OF ADDITIONAL WATER SUPPLIES IN THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill directs the Colorado water conservation board to study the feasibility of supplementing water supplies in the South Platte river basin through the construction of a new reservoir on the mainstem of the South Platte river between Greeley and Julesburg and the importation of water into Colorado from the Missouri river basin. The study must also estimate the volume of water that has been delivered to Nebraska above the

amounts required to be delivered by the South Platte river compact and that could otherwise have been stored in the lower South Platte river basin for each of the previous 20 years. The board must provide the water resources review committee and the governor's office with an update concerning the study by October 31, 2015, include the findings from the study in the Colorado water plan, complete the study by December 31, 2015, and provide a summary report on the study to the general assembly and the governor's office by February 15, 2016.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-60-115, add (10) 3 as follows: 4 37-60-115. Water studies - rules - repeal. (10) South Platte 5 river basin storage study. (a) THE BOARD, USING INFORMATION ALREADY COMPILED BY THE DRAFT COLORADO WATER PLAN AND THE 6 7 SOUTH PLATTE BASIN ROUNDTABLE CREATED IN SECTION 37-75-104 (3) 8 (b) (I), AND DIRECTLY COMMUNICATING WITH THAT BASIN ROUNDTABLE, 9 SHALL MAKE, OR CAUSE TO BE MADE, A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF 10 SUPPLEMENTING WATER SUPPLIES IN THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN 11 THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION OF ONE OR MORE NEW RESERVOIRS IN THE 12 SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN AND THE IMPORTATION OF WATER INTO 13 COLORADO FROM THE MISSOURI RIVER BASIN. THE GOALS OF THE STUDY 14 ARE TO: 15 (I) ASSESS THE SUITABILITY OF STORAGE SITES IN THE SOUTH 16 PLATTE RIVER BASIN, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY MAY PREVIOUSLY 17 HAVE BEEN STUDIED, INCLUDING THE MAINSTEM, TRIBUTARIES, 18 OFF-STREAM STORAGE, UNDERGROUND STORAGE, ENLARGEMENT OF 19 EXISTING RESERVOIRS, AND DREDGING OF EXISTING RESERVOIRS, TAKING 20 INTO CONSIDERATION THAT THE STORED WATER WOULD BE USED: 21 (A) FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER COMPACT,

2	(B) TO AUGMENT MUNICIPAL SUPPLIES, INCLUDING BY EXCHANGE;
3	(C) As a source of augmentation supply for Junior

5	(D) CONJUNCTIVELY WITH GROUNDWATER SUPPLIES, INCLUDING

8	THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN FROM OTHER BASINS IN COLORADO,
9	INCLUDING, SPECIFICALLY, THE COLORADO RIVER BASIN;
10	(II) ESTIMATE, FOR EACH OF THE PREVIOUS TWENTY YEARS, THE
11	VOLUME OF WATER THAT HAS BEEN DELIVERED TO $\overline{\text{N}}\text{EBRASKA}$ IN EXCESS
12	OF THE AMOUNTS REQUIRED TO BE DELIVERED BY THE SOUTH PLATTE
13	RIVER COMPACT, ARTICLE 65 OF THIS TITLE, AND THAT COULD OTHERWISE
14	HAVE BEEN STORED IN THE LOWER SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN;
15	(III) ASSESS THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW
16	RESERVOIR AT ONE OR MORE OF THE STORAGE SITES STUDIED PURSUANT
17	TO SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a), INCLUDING
18	CONSIDERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL, PERMITTING, WATER AVAILABILITY,
19	FINANCIAL, AND LEGAL CONSTRAINTS, INCLUDING THOSE IMPOSED BY THE
20	SOUTH PLATTE RIVER COMPACT AND THE "COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR
21	PLATTE RIVER RESEARCH AND OTHER EFFORTS RELATING TO
22	ENDANGERED SPECIES HABITATS ALONG THE CENTRAL PLATTE RIVER,
23	NEBRASKA";
24	(IV) ASSESS EXISTING STUDIES CONDUCTED IN COLORADO OR
25	OTHER STATES IN THE MISSOURI RIVER BASIN ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF
26	A PIPELINE TO IMPORT WATER INTO $\overline{\text{COLORADO FROM THE}}$ $\overline{\text{M}}$ ISSOURI RIVER
27	BASIN; AND

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1	(V) ESTIMATE THE COSTS AND BENEFITS OF INCREASING STORAGE
2	IN THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN BY DREDGING ONE OR MORE EXISTING
3	RESERVOIRS IN THE BASIN TO INCREASE THE AFFECTED RESERVOIRS'
4	AVAILABLE STORAGE CAPACITY.
5	(b) THE BOARD SHALL:
6	(I) PROVIDE THE WATER RESOURCES REVIEW COMMITTEE CREATED
7	IN SECTION 37-98-102, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, THE EXECUTIVE
8	DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND THE
9	GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE WITH JURISDICTION
10	OVER NATURAL RESOURCES WITH AN UPDATE CONCERNING THE STUDY BY
11	OCTOBER 31, 2015;
12	(II) INCLUDE THE FINDINGS FROM THE STUDY IN THE COLORADO
13	WATER PLAN;
14	(III) COMPLETE THE STUDY AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS PRACTICABLE,
15	BUT IN NO EVENT LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2015; AND
16	(IV) PROVIDE A REPORT SUMMARIZING THE STUDY TO THE
17	GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S COMMITTEES OF
18	REFERENCE WITH JURISDICTION OVER NATURAL RESOURCES BY FEBRUARY
19	15, 2016.
20	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
21	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
