Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 8 through 12 and substitute "THE
COURT SHALL NOT, AS A CONDITION OF PROBATION, PROHIBIT THE
POSSESSION OR USE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA, AS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT
TO SECTION 14 OF ARTICLE XVIII OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION, UNLESS:
(A) THE DEFENDANT IS SENTENCED TO PROBATION FOR
CONVICTION OF A CRIME UNDER ARTICLE 43.3 OF TITLE 12, C.R.S.; OR
(B) THE COURT DETERMINES, BASED ON THE ASSESSMENT AS
REQUIRED BY SECTION 18-1.3-209, A PROHIBITION AGAINST THE
POSSESSION OR USE OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA IS NECESSARY AND
APPROPRIATE TO ACCOMPLISH THE GOALS OF SENTENCING AS STATED IN
18-1-102.5.".
