#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$105,531 General Fund to the Department of Personnel for FY 2015-16. This provision states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.0 FTE to implement the act. This provision also reduces the FY2015-16 General Fund appropriation to the Statewide Planning Services line item in the Office of the State Architect by an equal amount.
