*Related Budget Information*

The Joint Budget Committee recently voted to include separate line items for Colorado Mountain College and Aims Community College in the FY 2015-16 Long Bill. Based on the Committee's action, the amount for each college will be based on its FY 2014-15 allocation, increased by the same amount as the overall increase in funding for the higher education governing boards. This approach is consistent with the provisions of H.B. 14-1319 (Outcomes-based funding for Higher Education) as clarified by this bill.
