### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$45,304 General Fund to the Legislative Council Staff in the Legislative Department for FY 2015-16. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.7 FTE.

## **Points to Consider**

The general appropriations bill for FY 2015-16 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$45,304 for FY 2015-16, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
