**BILL TOPIC:** REQUESTS FOR MULTIPLE BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS

**Summary of Legislation**

This bill allows a person requesting copies of one or more booking photographs to sign one required statement for all booking photographs requested for a period of up to one year.

**State Expenditures**

This bill could reduce workload for the Department of Public Safety by a minimal amount by reducing the number of required statements to be collected from a person requesting copies of multiple booking photographs.

**Local Government Impact**

Similar to the state, this bill could reduce workload by a minimal amount for local law enforcement agencies that accept statements in exchange for copies of booking photographs.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect and applies to requests for photographs made on or after this bill is signed by the Governor, or upon it's becoming law without his signature.
