#### **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, Routt County is classified as a category III county for purposes of establishing the salaries of county officers. This bill reclassifies the county as a category II county.

#### **Background**

All Colorado counties are assigned a category — I through IV — for the purpose of setting the salaries of elected county officials. In general, the counties in categories I through III are larger counties that are required to pay higher salaries than counties in categories IV and VI. The salary schedule does not affect the city and county of Denver and Broomfield, or the home rule counties (Pitkin and Weld) that choose to set their own compensation rates.

### **Local Government Impact**

The reclassification of Routt County from a category II to a category III county will result in salary increases for county officers when those officers are either elected or re-elected. Under current law, no sitting county official can receive a raise during their term.

Over the course of two elections, Routt County will see a total increase in required salary payments for elected officers of \$106,800; salary expenses increase by \$28,000 in January 2017, and increase again by \$78,880 beginning January 2019. This impact is displayed in Table 1.
