**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$5,304 to the Department of Revenue for FY 2015-16, including \$4,120 from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund and \$1,184 from the License Plate Cash Fund. The provision also authorizes the Governor's Office of Information and Technology to receive and spend \$4,120 from the Department of Revenue.
