FOR A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK, A REQUIREMENT THAT A PERMITTED ECONOMIC INTEREST APPLICANT SUBMIT TO AND PASS A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK, DIVESTITURE, AND OTHER AGREEMENTS THAT WOULD QUALIFY AS PERMITTED ECONOMIC INTERESTS.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-103, **amend** (12); and **add** (12.4) as follows:

12-43.4-103. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (12) "Owner" means any person having a beneficial interest, as defined by the state licensing authority, in a retail marijuana establishment OTHER THAN A HOLDER OF A PERMITTED ECONOMIC INTEREST.
- 13 (12.4) "PERMITTED ECONOMIC INTEREST" MEANS ANY UNSECURED 14 CONVERTIBLE DEBT INSTRUMENT, OPTION AGREEMENT, WARRANT, OR ANY 15 OTHER RIGHT TO OBTAIN AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST WHEN THE HOLDER OF 16 SUCH INTEREST IS A NATURAL PERSON WHO IS A LAWFUL UNITED STATES 17 RESIDENT AND WHOSE RIGHT TO CONVERT INTO AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST 18 IS CONTINGENT ON THE HOLDER OUALIFYING AND OBTAINING A LICENSE 19 AS AN OWNER UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR SUCH OTHER AGREEMENTS AS MAY 20 BE PERMITTED BY RULE BY THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY.
 - **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.4-202, **add** (3) (a) (XIV.5) as follows:
 - 12-43.4-202. Powers and duties of state licensing authority rules. (3) (a) Rules promulgated pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of this section must include, but need not be limited to, the following subjects:
 - (XIV.5) Rules effective on or before January 1, 2016, relating to permitted economic interests including a process for a criminal history record check, a requirement that a permitted economic interest applicant submit to and pass a criminal
