After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB15-264 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 15, after line 16 insert:

2 "SECTION 26. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-61-111.5,  
3 **amend** (2) (a) (II) as follows:

4 **12-61-111.5. Fee adjustments.** (2) (a) (II) The costs of the HOA  
5 information and resource center, created in section 12-61-406.5, shall be  
6 paid from the HOA information and resource center cash fund created in  
7 section 12-61-406.5. The division of real estate shall estimate the direct  
8 and indirect costs of operating the HOA information and resource center  
9 and shall establish the amount of the annual registration fee to be  
10 collected under section 38-33.3-401, C.R.S. The amount of the  
11 registration fee shall be sufficient to recover such costs, subject to a  
12 maximum limit of fifty dollars and subject to adjustment to reflect the  
13 actual direct and indirect costs of operating the HOA information and  
14 resource center pursuant to the general directive to adjust fees to avoid  
15 exceeding the statutory limit on uncommitted reserves in administrative  
16 agency cash funds as set forth in section ~~24-75-401(3)~~ 24-75-402 (3),  
17 C.R.S.".

19 Page 21, after line 15 insert:

1           **"SECTION 40.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-6.5-102, **amend**  
2 (11) (f) as follows:

3           **18-6.5-102. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the context  
4 otherwise requires:

5           (11) "Person with a disability" means any person who:

6           (f) Is mentally impaired as the term is defined in section  
7 ~~24-34-301 (2.5) (b) (II)~~ 24-34-501 (1.3) (b) (II), C.R.S.;"

8           Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

9           Page 31, after line 24 insert:

10           **"SECTION 59.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-70-105, **amend**  
11 (1) (f) as follows:

12           **23-70-105. General powers of the Auraria board.** (1) The  
13 Auraria board is a body corporate by the name and style of the board of  
14 directors of the Auraria higher education center and, as such and by its  
15 said name, has the power to:

16           (f) Employ, within funds appropriated for such purpose or  
17 otherwise made available therefor, such employees as are necessary to  
18 perform the functions and carry out the duties of the Auraria board,  
19 including ~~an executive vice-president for administration who shall be the~~  
20 A chief executive officer for operations at the Auraria campus WHO SHALL  
21 REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE AURARIA BOARD;"

22           Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

23           Page 38, after line 15 insert:

24           **"SECTION 76.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-17-305, **amend**  
25 (2) as follows:

26           **25-17-305. Immunity.** (2) A waste hauler, as that term is defined  
27 in section ~~30-20-1402 (16)~~ 30-20-1001 (16), C.R.S., or owner or operator  
28 of a landfill or transfer station does not violate this part 3 if the hauler,  
29 owner, or operator has made a good-faith effort to comply with this part  
30 3 by posting and maintaining, in a conspicuous location at the waste  
31 hauler's facility, transfer station, or the landfill, a sign stating that  
32 electronic devices will not be accepted at the facility, transfer station, or  
33 landfill.

34           **SECTION 77.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 25-20.5-502  
35 as follows:

1           **25-20.5-502. Definitions.** As used in this part 5, unless the  
2 context otherwise requires:

3           (1) "School-based health center" means a clinic established and  
4 operated within a public school building, including charter schools and  
5 state-sanctioned high school equivalency examination programs  
6 associated with a school district, or on public school property by the  
7 school district. School-based health centers are operated by school  
8 districts in cooperation with hospitals, public or private health care  
9 organizations, licensed medical providers, public health nurses,  
10 community health centers, and community mental health centers. The  
11 term "school-based health center" includes clinics or facilities authorized  
12 to provide clinic services pursuant to section ~~26-4-513~~ 25.5-5-301,  
13 C.R.S., or authorized to apply for and receive medical assistance  
14 payments under a contract entered into pursuant to section ~~26-4-531~~  
15 25.5-5-318, C.R.S."
