## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. J.001 (attached) provides the appropriation clause necessary for the decrease of personal services and operating expenses by the Division of Professions and Occupations. The appropriations clause also authorizes the decrease of legal services from the Department of Law by the Division of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies.

### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision decreasing cash funds appropriations by a total of \$87,562 to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2015-16 from the Division of Professions and Occupations. This provision also states that the appropriation reduction is based on the assumption that the Department will implement a decrease of 1.3 FTE. The appropriations clause also authorizes the decreased purchase of legal services from the Department of Law by the Division of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies.
