- J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision reducing appropriations by a total of \$56,548 cash funds to the Department of Revenue for FY 2015-16, including:
- (\$19,610) from the Limited Gaming Fund;
 - (\$16,417) from the Marijuana Cash Fund;
 - (\$9,577) from the Liquor Enforcement Division and State Licensing Authority Cash Fund;
 - (\$5,928) from the Auto Dealers License Fund;
 - (\$3,648) from the Lottery Fund; and
 - (\$1,368) from the Racing Cash Fund.
