A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATION TO PRACTICE SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

Current law requires applicants seeking a certification in speech-language pathology to complete certain educational requirements, pass a national examination, and complete a clinical fellowship. The bill allows applicants who have completed the educational requirements and passed the national examination to apply for a provisional certification before completing a clinical fellowship.

A provisional certificate holder may practice speech pathology only under the general supervision of a speech-language pathologist who holds a certificate of clinical competence from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association.

The provisional certification expires after 24 months or when the director issues the provisional certificate holder a full certification, whichever occurs first.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FEE 20 WITH THE APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR.
