Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$37,940 cash funds to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2015-16. This provision also appropriates \$37,606 to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2015-16, including \$10,815 General Fund and \$833 cash funds from various cash funds. This provision also states the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing will receive \$25,958 federal funds to implement the act. The provision appropriates \$7,426

reappropriated funds to the Department of Law for the purchase legal services by the Department of Regulatory Agencies in FY 2015-16.

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2015-16 based on the March 2015 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast.
