BILL TOPIC: ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS BY DOMESTIC ENTITIES

Summary of Legislation

This bill amends the Colorado Corporations and Associations Act to define "signature" or "signed" to include "electronic signature" as defined in the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (UETA) unless otherwise provided in the constituent document. The definition of "writing" or "written" is expanded to include an "electronic record" as defined in the UETA unless otherwise provided in the constituent document.

Assessment

This bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local agency so is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2015, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2015, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
