Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1367 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 7, line 24, strike "FEBRUARY 29, 2016, AND ON
2 THE LAST" and substitute "MARCH 3, 2016, AND ON THE THIRD".
- 3 Page 8, line 3, strike "MAY 31" and substitute "JUNE 3".
- 4 Page 8, line 27, strike "FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2017,".
- 5 Page 9, strike lines 3 through 6 and substitute "governments. The city or
6 town share ~~shall be~~".
- 7 Page 9, line 9, strike "bears" and substitute "~~bears~~ BEAR".
- 8 Page 9, strike lines 16 through 23 and substitute ""NO/AGAINST", THEN
9 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016, THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE
10 DISTRIBUTED TO A LOCAL GOVERNMENT THROUGH SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF
11 THIS PARAGRAPH (a) IS HALVED UNTIL THE TOTAL REDUCTION THAT
12 RESULTS FROM THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I.5) IS GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO
13 THE AMOUNT THAT WAS DISTRIBUTED TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER
14 THIS PARAGRAPH (a) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-15. THEREAFTER, THE
15 LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECEIVES THE FULL APPORTIONED AMOUNT
16 REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a). THE REDUCTION
17 IN A LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S DISTRIBUTION DOES NOT INCREASE THE
18 AMOUNT APPORTIONED TO OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.".

1 Page 10, strike lines 4 through 11 and substitute "PARAGRAPH (b), THE
2 STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE
3 MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO EIGHTY-FIVE PERCENT
4 OF THE GROSS RETAIL MARIJUANA SALES TAX REVENUES COLLECTED BY
5 THE DEPARTMENT."

6 Page 10, line 22, strike "2015-16 AND THE NEXT FOUR" and substitute
7 "2016-17 AND THE NEXT THREE".

8 Page 20, line 21, strike "39-22-2004." and substitute "39-22-2002."

9 Page 33, after line 2 insert:

10 **"SECTION 1. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2015-16 state fiscal
11 year, \$212,369 is appropriated to the department of local affairs. This
12 appropriation is from the marijuana tax cash fund created in section 39-
13 28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
14 appropriation as follows:

15 (a) \$132,599 for use by division of local government for the local
16 government retail marijuana impact grant program, which amount is
17 based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 2.0
18 FTE;

19 (b) \$79,770 for the purchase of information technology services.

20 (2) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$79,770 is appropriated to
21 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
22 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
23 department of local affairs under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this
24 section. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to
25 provide information technology services for the department of local
26 affairs.

27 (3) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$25,440 is appropriated to
28 the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the marijuana cash
29 tax fund created in section 39-28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act,
30 the department may use this appropriation for CITA annual maintenance
31 and support."
