Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that is not consistent with the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note, or with the amount set aside in the Joint Budget Committee package for this bill. See the discussion below of J.001 for more information.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to update the existing appropriations clause to provide \$269,912 General Fund to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2015-16. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 4.0 FTE, and the Department will receive \$269,911 federal funds to implement the act.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2015-16 based on the March 2015 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2015-16 budget package a \$269,912 General Fund appropriation for implementation of this bill.
