Summary of Legislation

The bill, **recommended by the Joint Budget Committee**, requires the state treasurer to transfer \$2,059,079 from the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Services Cash Fund to the General Fund on April 1, 2015. The bill repeals on July 1, 2016.

State Transfers

The bill transfers \$2,059,079 from the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Cash Fund within the Department of Human Services (DHS) to the General Fund on April 1, 2015.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
