## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill prohibits the board of the Tony Grampsas Youth Services Program from establishing a cap on the amount of grants awarded to organizations through the program. The grant program is administered and overseen by the Department of Human Services.

### **State Expenditures**

By removing the ability of the board to establish a cap on grant awards, the bill may change the amount of funding per grant and number of organizations receiving grants through the program. However, this change is not expected to affect the total cost of the program and no adjustment in appropriations is required.

### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 5, 2015, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2015, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
