101 **CONCERNING THE IMPORTANCE OF SELF-CARE, AND, IN CONNECTION**

- 102 THEREWITH, DECLARING FEBRUARY 2015 AS "SELF-CARE
 103 MONTH".
 - WHEREAS, Self-care is a lifelong daily habit of healthy lifestyle
 choices, good hygiene practices, prevention of infection and illness,
 avoiding unhealthy choices, monitoring for signs and symptoms of
 changes in health, knowing when to consult a health care practitioner, and
 knowing when it is appropriate to self-treat conditions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The United States food and drug administration 7 deems over-the-counter medicines safe and effective for the self-care 8 treatment of minor acute and chronic health conditions and symptoms 9 such as pain, the common cold, allergies, and other conditions that impact 10 large segments of the population; and

WHEREAS, Over-the-counter medicines are either developed as
 new nonprescription medicines or switched from existing prescription
 medicines; and

- WHEREAS, Over-the-counter nonprescription medicines are
 self-care products that consumers purchase in pharmacies, supermarkets,
 and other retail stores and on line; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Every dollar spent on over-the-counter medicines
 8 saves the United States health care system \$6 to \$7, totaling \$102 billion
 9 in annual savings; and
- WHEREAS, Nonprescription medicines help to ease the burden
 on health care practitioners, eliminating unnecessary medical
 examinations with appropriate self-care; and
- WHEREAS, Colorado benefits when its citizens practice
 appropriate self-care; do not unnecessarily visit health care practitioners;
 are empowered by higher self-esteem and improved health; and reduce
 use of Colorado's health care system; and
- WHEREAS, Colorado encourages its citizens to take advantage of
 the potential of self-care to improve personal and public health, save
 money for individuals and society, and strengthen the sustainability of
 Colorado's health care system; and
- WHEREAS, Achieving the full potential of self-care is a shared
 opportunity for consumers, health care practitioners, policymakers, and
 regulators; now, therefore,
