	designate a day to expressly recognize those contributions; and
	WHEREAS, Purebred dogs are living legacies of the cultures that
	created them, and historically these dogs worked alongside their people
	and provided them companionship; and
	WHEREAS, Today, the service of these breeds continues as they
	work alongside humans and provide inestimable companionship while
	serving as guide dogs, service dogs, conservation dogs, livestock
	guardians, search and rescue dogs, earth dogs, police dogs, canine
